





Tudor Grange Academy is very proud of the standards it maintains with uniform. This is achieved through the partnership between the Academy and home. To enable you to support the Academy the full uniform requirements for all Sixth Form students are provided in this guide.

The expectation is that ALL Sixth Form students attend in smart dark grey or black coloured business wear. The presence of a smart suit will also provide highly suitable attire for formal work experience placements in addition to university, apprenticeship and job interview scenarios.

For ALL Sixth Form students, smart suit/attire will need to be purchased that fulfils the criteria outlined below.

The following items can be purchased from our supplier for the lower school, PB Sports or alternatively can be sourced from a shop of your choice that fulfils the <u>dark grey/charcoal or black</u> requirement. Some suggestions of these shops and suppliers are outlined within this booklet.

Men's Suit Criteria

- o A plain dark grey or black suit jacket and trousers
 - Please note that suits should not be checked or patterned.
- o The men's suit should be accompanied by a white collared shirt.
- Official Tudor Grange Academy Kingshurst Sixth Form tie will be gifted to students at the point of commencing Sixth Form in September.
- Smart black leather shoes
- Optional: A dark grey or black V-neck or crew neck jumper may be worn in addition underneath the suit jacket. Where this is option is chosen, the shirt collar should still be visible.

Women's Suit Criteria

- A plain dark grey suit or black jacket and straight skirt or trousers
 - Please note that fabric should not be checked or patterned.
- The women's suit should be accompanied by a white collared blouse or white collared shirt if preferred.
 - For those girls choosing to wear a shirt, an official Tudor Grange Academy Kingshurst Sixth Form tie will be gifted to students at the point of commencing Sixth Form in September.
- Smart black leather shoes
- Optional: A dark grey or black V-neck jumper, crew neck jumper or cardigan may be work in addition underneath the suit jacket. Where this is option is chosen, the collar should still and visible.

Solihull Moors Dress Code:



Solihull Moors Academic Dress Code

Expectations of formal attire will remain identical for ALL of our students joining the Elite Education and Football Programme in Partnership with the Solihull Moors Foundation. This identical formal attire will be worn throughout the duration of each day and will changed out of prior to afternoon training within the Academy Pavilion changing room facilities (or venue used).

The Solihull Moors Foundation are likely to require students to purchase a kit pack that is solely to be worn during afternoon training sessions or competitive matches, and as such, the Solihull Moors Foundation will manage the ordering of kit items specifically with students aligned to this programme.

Astroturf Footwear

COMPULSORY KIT

- All footballers are reminded to wear the appropriate footwear for 3G based training session and matches:
 - Astro turf trainers or rounded moulded rubber studs are required for the 3G surface.
 - Astro turf trainers can be worn for all activities.
 - Athletic trainers can **only** be worn for any indoor training activities.

Please note that shoes, normal trainers, bladed boots and metal studded boots are not permitted on the 3G surface.



Mobile Phones

Phones are not to be used whilst on the school site during normal school hours, this includes any wireless 'ear-pod', over-the-ear headphones or music players. The only exception to this is the privilege of Sixth Form students to use these devices respectfully within the Sixth Form Common Room area.

If phones are seen or heard on the academy site outside of these areas, they will be confiscated. A second confiscation will require the parent/ carer/ nominated adult to collect the phone from the Student Services Office.

The following non-bespoke items can be purchased from the any suitable retailers in addition to those identified:



Shirts

• White buttoned shirt, which should be tucked in at all times.

Trousers

• Dark grey or black of an orthodox style, not unduly tapered or flared, **no** skinny style trousers or trousers that are tight at the ankles

Skirt

• Dark grey or black straight skirt to be worn on or just above the knee.

Tights

Students are encouraged to wear tights when wearing skirts. These need to be either
dark grey or black. Thick opaque tights are acceptable and advised. Patterned tights are
not acceptable. Tights must **not** be worn underneath socks.

Shoes

• Shoes should be plain black leather with a maximum heel height of 5cm and a maximum sole thickness of 2cm (the heel height is measured from the ground to the welt up the back of the heel). Boots, boot-style shoes, stiletto heels, sling-back shoes, canvas shoes, suede shoes, trainers and skater style shoes are not permitted.

Coats

We encourage students to wear coats in adverse weather conditions. Please do not wear
coats with slogans on that could cause offence to others and please note that coats are
not to be worn inside the academy buildings, inclusive of the Common Room. Students
will be asked to remove them when entering.

Academy Bag

 A school bag should be an appropriate size and be able to fit an A4 folder and be free of graffiti. Small hand/shoulder bags and carrier bags are not allowed.

Scarves and gloves

Similar to coats, if the weather is poor then scarves and gloves are encouraged. Please
note that they are not worn inside the academy buildings, inclusive of the Common
Room. Students will be asked to remove them when entering.

Turbans

Black or dark grey.

Hijabs

 Black or dark grey and pinned under the chin to stay on the head comfortably. Hijabs worn around the neck only are not permitted.

Hairstyles, Jewellery and Make-Up

Extreme hairstyles, cuts and colours are not allowed on any occasion. Examples
of extreme hairstyles, including close shaved, decoratively shaved, two-tone
colouring, extensive highlighting and decorative braiding, are not allowed.



- Any dyed hair must be a natural hair colour.
- Hairbands and slides, if worn, should be plain black.
- Students are permitted one pair of plain stud earrings (silver or gold). These are to be worn in the lower ear lobe only. No other piercings are allowed (nose, tongue or upper ear etc.)
- Watches may be worn, but no bracelets except for those with a medical purpose.
- Students may wear a discreet amount of mascara only.
- Nail varnish or false nails are not allowed; nails should be of a safe length to avoid injury to self or others.

Please remember:

- All uniform must be clearly labelled. The use of laundry markers is proving to be most
 effective in the re-turn of mislaid items. In travelling to and from the Academy, while at
 the Academy, and while representing the Academy at functions or matches, students
 must wear full Sixth Form Academy uniform.
- Sixth Form uniform is also normally to be worn during educational visits.

Note

If a student arrives at school with incorrect uniform their College Leader for Sixth Form/ Assistant College Leader for Sixth Form or Senior Leadership Team member may:

- (a) Send the student home to change, having first contacted the parents,
- (b) Send the student to a Sixth Form resource to work for the day.

The Principal's decision on acceptable uniform is final.

School Trouser & Skirt Guidance

The following information has been provided to help parents and carers in identifying what styles of trousers and skirts are suitable for school wear.

Our Uniform Policy clearly stipulates that tight fitting trousers, leggings, shorts, cargo pant or fashion trousers of any kind are not permitted in school.

Whilst this is not designed to be an exhaustive list, and bearing in mind that shop stock and styles will change, we hope that this guidance will be useful when purchasing school uniform items for your child.
