For those who opted into receiving free online tuition, your two, one-hour online sessions per requested subject will start this week, beginning **Monday 3rd June**.

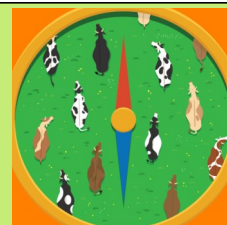
