“The Final Countdown” For Year 11 and Year 13

Thank goodness hairstyles have progressed from that of the 1980's, however, Europe's popular track from the 1986 will be experiencing a resurgence as a result of our Year 11 and Year 13 students being in the final week of them being required to attend the Academy.

Despite both GCSE and A Level examinations taking place until Wednesday 19th June and Friday 21st June 2024 respectively, these will be for smaller cohorts of students and therefore **Friday 14th June will mark the final day that these students will attend their timetabled lessons (inclusive of this day).**

Safeguarding is of primary importance and therefore, as of Monday 17th June, any Year 11 or Year 13 student attending the academy will be required to:

1. If arriving prior to 8.30am, can enter via the normal pedestrian entrance and for Year 11, sign in at the DINING AREA with the Bronte College Administrator or Student Services in

the case of Year 13 students.

2. If arriving after 8.30am for a planned revision session with their teacher, or for their afternoon examination, Year 11 students will need to enter and sign-in via the Main Reception. Similarly, Sixth Form students will enter via the Main reception and make their way independently to the Student Services office to sign-in with the College Administrator for Sixth Form.
3. When leaving the Academy following their examination, both Year 11 and Year 13 students are required to sign out via the Student Services Office with the respective College Administrator for either Bronte (Year 11) or Sixth Form.

A specific Leaver's Assembly event is scheduled for the afternoon of Friday 21st June where student will be able to sign shirts, enjoy a BBQ and ice cream whilst being able to catch-up with their peers and teachers.

Year 10 Mock Examinations

With the advent of formal examinations drawing to a close for our current Year 11 cohort, we now look to immediately begin the process of supporting our Year 10 pupils in building their experience, resilience and clear understanding of the process for their real examinations in summer 2025.

Mock examinations in the core subjects of English, Mathematics and Science, will begin on the morning of Monday 24th June and will finish as of the afternoon of Thursday 27th June 2024. Taking extra sun safety precautions

A shocking 51% of Brits surveyed by the British Skin Foundation (BSF) have accidentally sunburned themselves, despite 81% of respondents stating that sun safety precautions are important to them and their families.

In response to this, the BSF has launched its 'More, More, More' sun safety campaign. This initiative encourages Brits to wear more protective clothing, use more sunscreen, and seek more shade during the summer. With a quarter of those surveyed admitting they forget about sun safety and need regular reminders, this campaign provides the necessary prompts to help the British public maintain their skin health. Sunscreen. No one likes it.

But whether you're a sun lover or a shade seeker, sun safety is more important than ever. Grab the sunscreen, style out the sun hat, and always remember – when it comes to looking after your skin this summer, **there's no such thing as too much protection.**



Three steps for skin safety

- 1 More protective clothing** – cover up exposed skin with UPF clothing, wear a wide-brimmed hat and sunglasses with UV protection.
- 2 More sunscreen** – use SPF 30 or above sunscreen on exposed skin and reapply at least every 2 hours or after swimming/sweating etc.
- 3 More shade** – especially between 11am-3pm when the UV index is highest. Keep babies and young children out of direct sunlight.
